1900 United States Federal Census incorrectly lists place of birth as Russia. (Ancestry.com, 1900 United States Federal Census, Year: 1900; Census Place: Philadelphia Ward 17, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; Roll: T623 1459; Page: 9B; Enumeration District: 326.) Since he was born in 1889, and his mother & father had immigrated to America in 1888 it is not possible he was born in Russia. Place of birth is listed as Philadelphia by his World War I Draft Registration Card, which is in part supported by his residency in Philadelphia at the time of the 1900 Census (Ancestry.com, World War I Draft Registration Cards, 1917-1918, [database on-line]. Provo, UT, USA: The Generations Network, Inc., 2005, Original data: United States, Selective Service System. World War I Selective Service System Draft Registration Cards, 1917-1918. Article from 7 Oct 2004 in Salt Lake Tribune incorrectly states Linda died in 2002. (Michael N. Westley, The Salt Lake Tribune, Police arrest ex-con in woman's death, 7 Oct 2004, Pg. C2.). It also incorrectly states cause of death as cancer.

Her obituary in The Oregonian was published 4 Nov 2001, and states death occurred 30 Oct 2001 (The Oregonian, "Linda Karel Saxey Obituary," 4 Nov 2001, Sunrise edition, pg. D12.) Michelle Saxey states cause of death as a brain aneurysm, and stated "The date is a little disputable because she was found a little late so it's a best guesstimate on how long she had been laying in the house alone before someone came. I was her last phone call I believe, some things one can never forget and I think it was on Oct 29th when she passed away." (Michelle Saxey Interview, Email, 6 Sep 2009)
